First of all, best wishes for a Happy and Healthy New Year. Let's hope that 2022 will end on a better note pandemic-wise than 2021!

I get back to the issue of your AZ delivery and donation figures, which we raised with AZ. The AZ deliveries to the Netherlands were at your request suspended for a certain time in 2021. The approach on suspended doses agreed between the EU and AZ is that they will be proportionately allocated to the MS that are receiving or donating, and that the suspending country would catch up when delivery and/or donations resume. This would however not happen in one go for the suspended amount, as this would affect the delivery of the doses to the other countries, but spread out over time.

After the period of suspension the Netherlands declared the intention to donate all remaining 2021 doses to Gavi. The donation commitment was finalised in October, and from then on has been used to donate indeed via Gavi the doses that were allocated to the Netherlands. This amount has been lower than the amount you would have theoretically received, had there not been a period of suspension + donation commitment not yet finalised.

Since the AZ contract is finishing end March 2021, you should indeed receive in the last allocations the remainder that is due for the Netherlands. We have already asked AZ to provide the figures for those last allocations.

I hope this explanation is acceptable for you to explain the difference between the amount in your donation commitment and the amounts that GAVI received as donation from the Netherlands. GAVI have also asked the Commission for an explanation, but I prefer that the situation is first clarified with you.

Please let us know if you would like to discuss the matter in a call.

I am contacting you regarding your question on the AZ donations to COVAX where you note a discrepancy between the COVAX figure (in the order 5.1.1c and your own figure (about 5.1.1c).

At our end I see that you have informed the EC in October that the Netherlands intended to donate all their AZ to COVAX from the moment of suspension onwards (see attached email). If I understand your email correctly, you have provided donation commitment letters for the entire amount of those doses. It would be helpful if you could share them with us.

How can the volume of doses in order notices differ from the volume of doses in donation mandates? As far as we know, we have committed 5.1.1c to COVAX so far (see details below).

The numbers for Pfizer and Moderna match exactly with the list the EC distributed; Janssen is almost the same; AZ is much lower. This matches with what we've heard about deliveries this year – so we assumed the list the EC distributed was an overview of planned deliveries in 2021. The EC list brings the total for the Netherlands to

And then, the numbers in the [dashboard](#) don't match with either one of these lists. It says we have donated 5.1.1c doses, of which 5.1.1c Moderna (!). Also, our bilateral donations that are listed in the dashboard are (correct but) not complete.

Could someone (Gavi/EC) please tell us who can give us the correct numbers (for (planned) deliveries this year)?
