Dear all,

It has been a while since we had regular Periscope T cell meetings, due to corona.
 I hope you are all well!

Many Periscope T cell studies are in progress and new data are being generated and analysed, or expected to be shortly.

With the end of the project in sight, there is a lot of (exciting) work to do: not only the analysis of data from single assay/study combinations but also the vertical bioinformatic analysis of all data from all studies.

There are upcoming Periscope-wide meetings where data, storylines and knowledge gaps will be discussed (one online meeting on 24 March, and our face2face annual meeting in Ghent (16-18 May).

However, in order to be well prepared to present and discuss our combined T cell data, I would like to inventorize within the T cell stakeholder group where we stand.

For this I will try to schedule two meetings before 24 March and ask you to prepare a compact short presentation of your T-cell data/manuscript in preparation.

From this we can identify action points and knowledge/analysis gaps, which we can try to fill before the Ghent meeting.

Attached you find a concept overall agenda of all T-cell studies ongoing as far as I know.
